- 2001-2009**  
George Bush inaugurated Points of Light campaign to champion volunteer and community initiatives around the country
- 2009**  
Government support for community service and volunteering is at an all-time high. Interest among young people in AmeriCorps, the Peace Corps, and service-oriented NPO's such as Teach for America is growing.
- 2009**  
Edward M. Kennedy Serve America Act could fund up to 250,000 new AmeriCorps and VISTA volunteers supported by federal government
- 2011**  
Over Decades, the Corporation and AmeriCorps have funded thousands of AmeriCorps volunteers, providing support in range of service including early-childhood education.  
5.2m disadvantaged youth tutored, mentored, or served by AmeriCorps members in 2011
- 2016-2018**  
Trump Administration (first 100 days) focus on strategy, includes NPO leaders providing funding and leadership, guidance that provide resolutions.
- 2016-2018**  
Trump Administration will reverse course on official funding for aid to vulnerable communities, need reliance on philanthropy
- 2019**  
Charitable Tax Deduction, \$24k deduction for joint filers impact, make common cause with donors, influencers, peer NPO leaders
- 2019**  
Data consistently show that charitable organizations do not have sufficient financial and human resources to meet the needs of our nation's communities. NPO's can and should participate in the development of job growth policies at the federal, state, and local levels.
- 2019**  
As federal and state policymakers revisit health care laws, the National Council of Nonprofits encourages adoption of policies that enable workers to have access to health coverage, ensure that health care policy changes designed to provide coverage cost savings, increased flexibility, higher quality coverage apply to NPO workers
- 2019**  
The National Council of Nonprofits works to support NPO advocacy and to maintain the advocacy rights of organizations to promote, support, and protect NPO advocacy
